y husband and I vacationed in Arizona for our anniversary this year. What a marvelous world the Lord created! I had never been to the Grand Canyon or Sedona, Arizona. Both places were amazing and beautiful. *Thus the beavens* and the earth were com-

pleted in all their vast array (Genesis 2:1).

We flew to Phoenix, rented a car and then drove to Williams, Arizona. From there we took the Grand Canyon Railway to the South Rim and spent a day and a half seeing the majestic Grand Canyon. Pictures just don't do it justice. Then we drove to Sedona, Arizona and stayed at the Sky Ranch Lodge. The Lodge sits high above Sedona and has a special viewing area where we could see the red rock formations that surround Sedona and the sunsets. This part of our trip included a tour of the Ancient Ruins through towering red rock formations and learning about the 700-year-old Sinaguan Cliff Dwelling. A knowledgeable guide explained more to us about the people, customs, myths and legends of these native people.

For my husband and I the trip was a time to ponder the wonder of God's creation. We praise Him for His creation. But, the Grand Canyon guides and print information quoted and promoted evolution as they tried to explain why the Grand Canyon existed. And Sedona, AR is a popular location for people who follow New Age beliefs. Soon after we returned from this trip I set up a radio interview with Dr. Andrew Snelling, a geologist, scientist, and speaker for Answers in Genesis. He is an expert on the Grand Canyon. Rev. Warren Woerth co-hosted the radio program with me. It was educational and enlightening.

United States population holds a Christian Worldview today? We need to help our children, youth, and young adults learn to defend their faith. How can we help our children learn to appreciate and understand the glorious creation of God?

If you have children, the following is an activity that you can do together. Take a sheet of paper and write "a" through "z" down the left side. Then take a walk together through a park and help them think of things they see that begin with "a." What do you think they will find? Yes, probably some will find an ant. Then look for something that begins with "b." Those little ones will find a bug and will have a great time doing it. Maybe "c" could be a Cardinal or cocoon. Depending upon their age, you can help them write the words, spell the words, and give them hints for things that they could find. Then spend time talking to them about the wonderful world that God created—the ants, the bugs, the trees, the mountains, and the beautiful blue sky.

I would also recommend every family visit the Creation Museum in Petersburg, KY. This was one of the last vacations that my husband and I took with our son, Jeff, in August of 2009. It was taken just months before Jeff was diagnosed with stage four cancer. He was 32 years old when he passed from this life to the next. As we traveled home after visiting the Creation Museum, Jeff talked with us about how much the Creation Museum had helped educate him about the Lord's creation. He told us that he had friends that didn't believe God created the world and he wanted to tell them what he had learned at the Creation Museum. (For more information, visit www.creationmuseum.org.)
