t's true! Jesus' name is the hope of the world! Thank you for your partnership with us as we proclaim the Gospel to the world.

I founded Family Shield Ministries, a Recognized Service Organization of The Lutheran Church—Missouri Synod, after being involved in education and evangelism for many years.

Little did I know when we became a non-profit ministry in 1994 that the Lord would open the door for us to proclaim the weekly *Family Shield* radio program throughout the United States and the world. Today the program is broadcast on 53 stations.

But our radio outreach is just one of the ways we reach and equip individuals and their families for Christ. We also mentor and equip people through other educational and evangelism services. Obviously there is a great need to reach and equip all individuals and their families for Christ. And, as you will see from the Pew Report that is shared below, today the need is greater than ever before.

Why does Family Shield Ministries (FSM) exist and what are the goals? FSM strives to:

- Clearly articulate the Gospel that those who do not know Christ might come to faith;
- Equip Christians to apply faith to life situations, grow in the knowledge of God's Word, and use their gifts to serve and witness in the home, church, and community;
- Connect people to resources;
- Develop partnerships and collaborations; and
- Help individuals and their families implement the six traits of healthy families.

What does the Pew Research say about the Church and today's families?

The Christian share of the United States population is declining and the number of U.S. adults who do not identify with any organized religion is growing, according to an extensive new survey by the Pew Research Center. While "His name will be the hope of the world"

Matthew 12:21

the drop in Christian affiliation is particularly pronounced among young adults, it is occurring among Americans of all ages. The same trends are seen among whites, blacks, and Latinos; among both college graduates and adults with only a high school education; and among women as well as men.

The United States remains home to more Christians than any other country in the world, and a large majority of Americans - roughly seven in ten - continue to identify with some branch of the Christian faith. But the major new survey of more than 35,000 Americans by the Pew Research Center finds that the percentage of adults (ages 18 and older) who describe themselves as Christians has dropped by nearly eight percentage points in just seven years, from 78.4% in an equally massive Pew Research survey in 2007 to 70.6% in 2014. Over the same period, the percentage of Americans who are religiously unaffiliated - describing themselves as atheist, agnostic or 'nothing in particular' - has jumped more than six points, from 16.1% to 22.8%. And the share of American's who identify with non-Christian faiths also has inched up, rising 1.2 percentage points, from 4.7% in 2007 to 5.9% in 2014. Growth has been especially great among Muslims and Hindus, albeit from a very low base.

Family Shield Ministries Proclaims the Gospel and God's Word Beyond the Walls of the Church

Our name is based on Eph. 6:16 that says, "Take up the shield of faith." The mission is to educate and equip people, through the power of the Gospel, to know Christ, grow in His Word, and strengthen individuals and their families.

We accomplish the mission through outreach and educational ministries and services that include the weekly half-hour *Family Shield* radio program; the educational *Continued on page 2*

programs on family life, spiritual growth, and learning to witness; the counter-cult ministry that helps family members and friends of Jehovah's Witnesses and Mormons cope with and witness to loved ones involved in these organizations; and connecting people to important resources.


Radio Program: The *Family Shield* radio program is a weekly half-hour program that has been broadcast for 22 years and is currently heard on 53 radio stations throughout the United States. Our media consultant documented that 800,000 people listen to our program each week. And according to the George Barna Resource Group 10 to 15 percent of radio listeners are unchurched. Topics include: family life, spiritual growth, missions, and learning to witness. We feature LCMS and Christian experts on a wide range of topics that are relevant to issues today's families and the Church face.

One way we connect people to resources through the radio program is by featuring like-minded ministries. Over the years we have partnered with and featured many LCMS organizations and their leaders. Sample organizations include: Concordia Seminary–St. Louis; Lutheran Indian Ministries, Concordia University–WI, Ongoing Ambassadors for Christ, Transforming Churches Network, Lutheran Hour Ministries, and Lutheran Federal Credit Union.

Counter-Cult Ministry: The FSM Counter-Cult Ministry shares the Christ of the Bible with Mormons, Jehovah's Witnesses, and assists family members and friends as they learn to cope and witness to loved ones. The ministry:

- Offers prayer, training seminars and workshops to congregations, circuits, districts, and conventions on "Witnessing to Jehovah's Witnesses" and "Witnessing to Mormons."
- Produces radio programs on cults, the occult (New Age, Wicca) and false religions (Muslims) and promotes them through the archive page.
- Refers and connects individuals to appropriate resources and products.
- Networks with other apologetic organizations and experts knowledgeable in the area of cults, the occult and false religions.

Follow Up: The Family Shield Follow-Up Service answers telephone calls, emails, and responds to social media contacts from over 6,000 people each year. Last year 325 people contacted us that were unchurched or did not know Christ as their Savior. Many people contact us asking for prayer for a family member or friend or resources. The follow up services offers a weekly

issue-oriented booklet to listeners who request them, and also refers people to local congregations.

Educational Programs: Family Shield Ministries designs and presents educational programs on topics such as family life, parenting, spiritual growth, apologetics, and learning to witness. Three popular six hour seminars are "Families—Go First into the Home," "Responding and Witnessing to Jehovah's Witnesses," and "Witnessing—A Lifestyle."

Connecting Individuals to Resources: Family Shield recognizes that one of the challenges individuals, families and church leaders face is finding resources that meet their needs. We strive through all ministries and services to share resources (people, products, and organizations) with those who contact us. Besides featuring many authors and others that produce resources, Family Shield Ministries has also produced articles, devotions, booklets, Bible studies and books.

Another way we promote and connect people to resources is through the "Recommended Links" on our website. Eleven categories include: Children, Youth, and Family; Christian Resources; Christian Counselors; Apologetic Christian Organizations; Creation Science; Health and Healing; Substance Abuse; Development/Funding; Unemployment; Lutheran Organizations and Congregations; and Foundations.

Sharing the Law and Gospel: Family Shield Ministries shares the law and Gospel and strives to help those who do not yet know Christ, or who are confused about spiritual issues, to learn about their Savior, Jesus Christ, as well as God's Word. We also equip Christians to serve and witness in their home, church, and community. Those we reach and equip are serving in many and varied ways throughout the United States in their congregations and communities.

- "I spoke with Kevin last week. Before he placed his faith in Christ he was an Atheist. He heard the Gospel for the first time on Christian radio. *Family Shield* was one of the programs. What a blessing to learn how the Lord touched him and used our ministry." Kay Meyer
