hank you for your interest in Family Shield Ministries and for being a partner in strengthening today's families. You are special and we appreciate you!

Would you agree that there is a critical need to reach, equip and strengthen individuals and their families for Christ? It's a fact. Our mission and vision are more important now than

ever before! Your involvement and support are critical as we look to the Lord for guidance, share the saving Gospel message, and work together to expand our work beyond the walls of the Church!

We equip individuals and their families to implement the six traits that build strong, healthy families. The six traits are based on over 25 years of research documented in *Fantastic Families* and *Secrets of Strong Families*. They include: 1) Commitment, 2) Appreciation and Affection, 3) Positive Communication, 4) Spending Time Together, 5) Spiritual Well-being, and 6) The Ability to Cope with Stress and Crises.

One way we accomplish the mission and vision is through the *Family Shield* radio program that is now heard by more than 800,000 people on 54 stations each week. We pray you are listening, growing in faith, and telling family and friends about the program and ministry! The radio program addresses parenting, family life, ministry and apologetics. It equips listeners to know Christ, grow in faith, and learn to witness in a loving Christ-centered way.

Sometimes people think I just walk into the studio and do the weekly *Family Shield* radio program, but there is a lot of preparation and research involved prior to interviewing my guests. Sometimes preparing for a radio program involves reading an author's book or researching the topic. I always learn so much as I prepare for the program!


We receive hundreds of books to review each year from many publishers. I normally select the topic and then research who would make the best guest. Securing a contact number and email for our guest expert can be difficult. Once I have them, we set the date for the interview and send our guest a FSM "Radio Guest"

document that has additional information. We prepare the introduction and interview questions in advance, and get a second contact number in case there's a phone service glitch the day of taping.

After the program is recorded, Dave Powell prepares it for broadcasting, then sends the document to our radio distribution manager who makes sure the program is sent to all the radio stations. Before the program airs we also inform our "Response Center and Follow-up Services" leaders which booklet or resource we are offering the listeners.

We respond to over 6,000 people annually and strive to encourage and equip all who contact us. We frequently add organizations and agencies to our "Recommended Links" on the website. We also offer follow-up services to over 6,000 people each year, and produce and connect people to important resources. Research shows that children and teens that eat with their families regularly are less likely to drink, smoke, take illegal drugs, get pregnant outside of marriage, suffer from depression, or develop eating disorders. Children who enjoy family meals together have a larger vocabulary, higher self-esteem and more resilience. In adulthood, they tend to have better marriages. Research from the University of Michigan found that the amount of meal times children/teens share with their families was the single strongest

predictor of high a c a d e mic achievement scores. So, strengthen your family by eating meals together!
