am blessed to have many wonderful friends like you that support the ministry with their time, talents and treasures. Thank you!

Many of you know that in March 2018, I was diagnosed with lymphoma cancer. Thankfully it was caught early. I went through chemo treatments and in August 2018 I was told by my doctor that I

was cancer free. We praise the Lord for His healing and for the wonderful doctors, nurses and technicians that used their gifts to serve! I feel wonderful and recently had my first year anniversary test that indicates I am still cancer free. Thank you for your prayers!

However, dealing with the illness helped me realize that it was time to turn the leadership of Family Shield Ministries over to a new, younger leader. The Family Shield Board of Directors and I have been working toward this goal for over a year. The Transition Task Force completed the job description for our new executive director and the Board of Directors recently approved it. Now we are raising the support needed to accomplish our expansion plans for the future. The "Step into the Future" Fund Raising Drive will be announced at the Family Shield 25th Anniversary Celebration. Our funding goal is \$200,000.

Rev. Mark Frith, a Family Shield Board Member and Vice-President of Ministry Support for Lutheran Church Extension Fund (LCEF), serving the Central Region, has been working with the Family Shield Board of Directors to revise our vision statement.

After we hire the executive director, I will continue to host the *Family Shield* radio program and podcast as a volunteer. I will also help our new leader get acquainted with internal & external contracted staff, volunteers, donors, and our important outreach ministries.

I thank all of you for your support over the years, and ask that you continue to pray for and financially support Family Shield Ministries as it continues to educate and equip people, through the power of the Gospel, to know Christ, to grow in His Word, and to strengthen individuals and their families!

God Created the Family and the Church

The Lord created the family and the Church as the foundation of society. Would you agree with us that both of these institutions are under attack in today's world? And would you also agree that individuals and their families need the Gospel today more than ever before? It is the Gospel of Christ that transforms lives!

Why do today's families need Christ?

- The family is the first community of faith and has the most powerful influence on the faith of children and teens.
- The United States is the third largest mission field in the world.
- In 2016, 73.7% of people identified as Christians while 18.2% claimed no religious affiliation.
- Seventy percent (70%) of church-going teens stop going to church upon starting college according to *LifeWay Research* in 2017.
- Children born between 1999 and 2015 are more than twice as likely to be atheists than previous generations, according to 2018 Barna research findings.

Individuals and families need to know Christ and grow in the knowledge of God's Word so they can stand firm (Eph. 6:13-14) and use the shield of faith (Eph. 6:16). Although God created the family and the Church, today many people think they can change what God has declared in the Bible. But, they can't! God's Word is the Sword of the Spirit (Eph. 6:17).

The following statistics give insight into the changes and challenges today's families face:

- Overall, marriage rates in the United States have fallen from 72% in 1960 to just 51% in 2012, according to *The Economist.*
- Today 23 percent of our children live with a single mother. Forty percent (40%) of babies in the United States are being born to unmarried parents, a trend that has risen steadily over the past five decades.
- According to the National Center for Fathering, more than 20 million children live in a home without the physical *Continued on page 2*

presence of a father. Millions more have dads who are physically present, but emotionally absent.

- The US Census Bureau reports that an estimated 24.7 million children (33%) live absent their biological father.
- Many grandparents are stepping in to raise their grandchildren when the children's parents are not able or willing to do so. The U.S. Census of 2000 found that over 2.4 million grandparents have responsibility for their grandchildren.
- Nearly 700,000 children are abused in the United States annually. Child Protective Services (CPS) protects more than 3 million children.
- Neglect is the most common form of maltreatment. About four out of five abusers are the victims' parents. One in three children entered foster care in 2017 because of parental drug abuse.
- Nearly 21 million Americans struggle with substance addictions. Only one in 10 people with substance addictions receive treatment.
- Abortion has taken the lives of 60,069,971 unborn babies since the Roe vs. Wade decision in 1973.

The Radio Program and Podcast

The Family Shield radio program is aired on more than 50 stations throughout the United States and heard by more than 800,000 people each week. Kay Meyer, the founder, president, and host, has interviewed more than 1,200 Christian experts over the past 25 years. The new podcast helps us reach younger listeners through the Internet. The host and our guests proclaim the Gospel in a kind, caring way to all who listen. Research by Barna Group documented that 10-15% of all Christian radio listeners are unchurched. This makes our radio ministry an excellent opportunity for outreach.

The radio program is heard in places the church can't go...into the homes of those who are not Christians, and into prisons where prisoners listen and write us asking for help. It is heard by those driving along busy expressways and remote country roads, by parents dealing with rebellious teenagers, children and youth addicted to drugs and alcohol, and by those who know nothing about God but want to know Him.

Radio and podcast topics include: family life, parenting, marriage, spiritual growth, life issues, apologetics, and learning to witness.

Over 325 of those who contact us each year are unchurched or do not yet know Christ. During the past 25 years we have served more than 150,000 people!

Trecently returned from speaking at the "Witnesses Now for Jesus" Midwest Convention which was coordinated by Charles Smith, a former Jehovah's Witness. I spoke on "Proclaiming the Dual Nature of Christ to Jehovah's Witnesses." A copy of my book, *Mission Field on Our Doorstep: Jehovah's Witnesses*, and complimentary tracts were given to all participants.

What a blessing it was to meet so many ex-Jehovah's Witnesses that are now Christians! And to meet Christians who are striving to witness to friends and families that are involved with Jehovah's Witnesses. I also met many apologetic Christian leaders helping those who are leaving. And I met numerous people who want to leave. Carol was one of them. When I asked if she was an ex-Jehovah's Witness she said, 'No, I'm fading.' This means she is not active anymore.

Carol went on to tell me that her brother and sister-in-law had just asked her to leave their home where she had been living. They know she is going to leave the Watchtower Society and they will no longer help her. This is part of the Watchtower Society's disfellowshipping practices. She is dealing with a lot of anxiety and fear. We shared the Gospel and prayed with her.

When I asked where she was living now, she told me that a Christian woman who attends a Bible study near her home heard about her situation and offered her a bedroom in her home.

Jehovah's Witnesses that leave the Watchtower Society need people to offer help and support in many and varied ways. They need God's help and they need our prayers. While funds may be authorized for transfer at any time by a donor, it is particularly beneficial if you are 70 $\frac{1}{2}$ or older. Instead of taking the Required Minimum Distribution (RMD) from your IRA, which is taxable as ordinary income, if you are at least 70 $\frac{1}{2}$ years old, you may transfer funds as a contribution to the work of FSM which is not taxable.
